Please note this amended policy regarding the add/drop deadlines for IFL Courses.

Add:

Students may add IFL courses through the end of the first week of the term or with permission of the instructor if they wish to add after the add deadline.

Drop:

If the IFL course is dropped prior to the drop deadline, there are no academic or financial penalties.

If the IFL course is dropped after the drop deadline, but prior to the first course meeting, a W (Withdrawal) will be recorded on the student's transcript.

If the IFL course is dropped after the course begins, a WF (Withdrawal Fail) will be recorded on the student's transcript.

If a student does not officially drop the IFL course and does not show, or complete the course, an F (Fail) will be recorded on the student's transcript.
