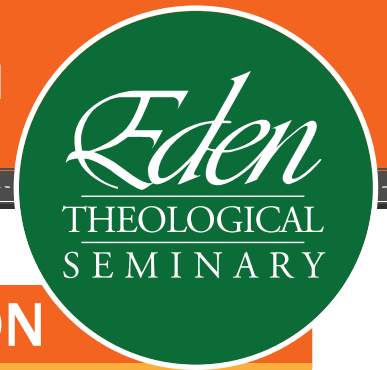

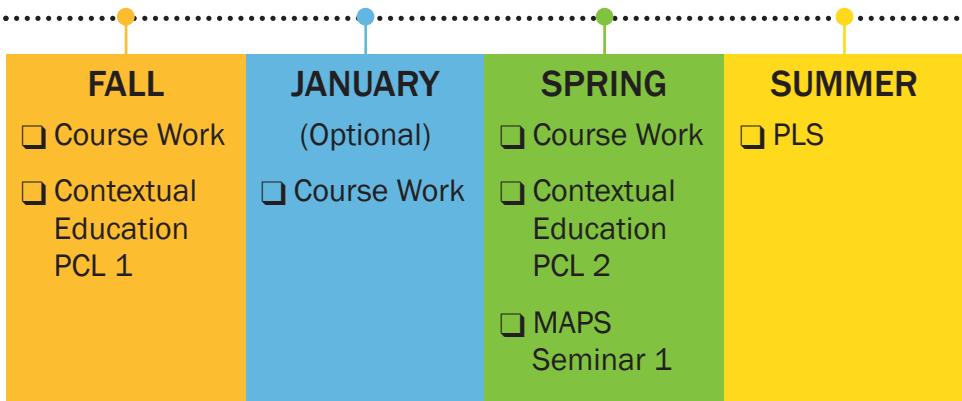
Capstone Project

- The culmination of the student's learning and practice that will produce a model and/or business plan for their future use.

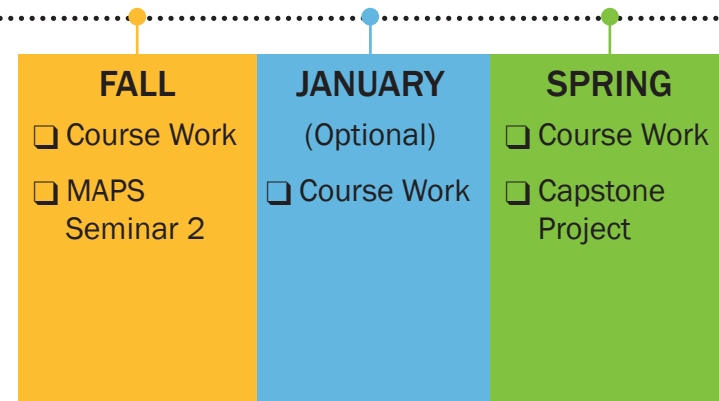

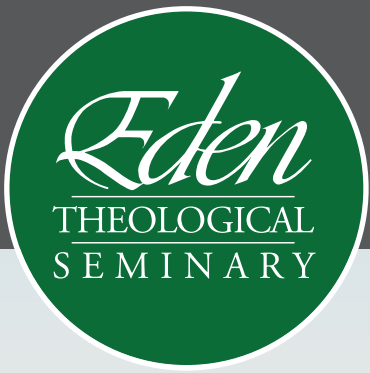
