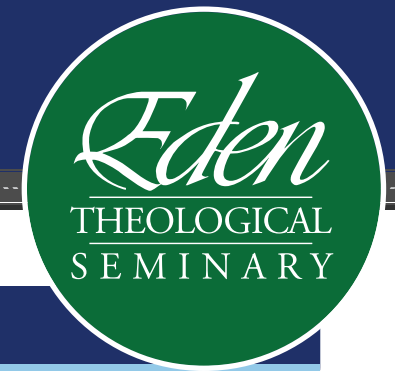

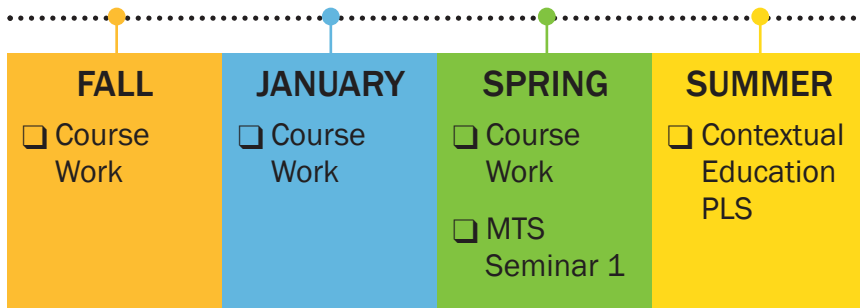
### MTS Seminars

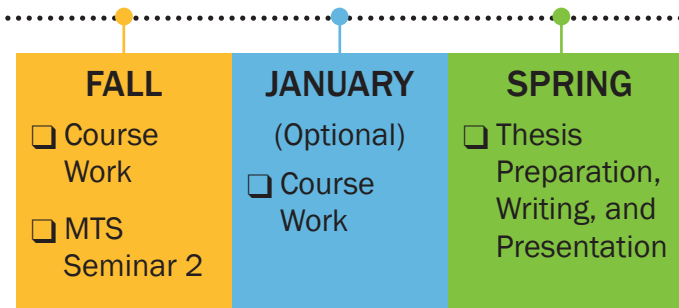

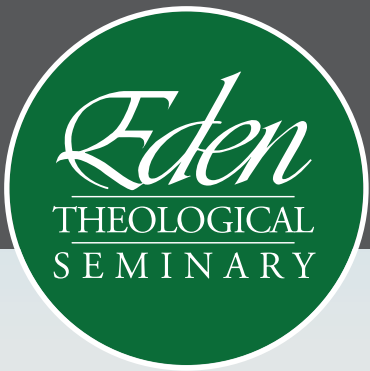
