Eden Scholarship

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student in a degree program;
- OR be admitted into the program for the year in which you are applying by the Scholarship application due date.
- Must complete the Scholarship Application and return it by the application due date.

*If you have been informed that you have utilized all the aggregated graduate unsubsidized loan funds (\$73,000+), please contact the Financial Aid office.

- **Note:** Eden utilizes Campus Ivy as our 3rd party loan processor, students utilizing Federal Direct Loans must monitor the Campus Ivy Virtual Financial Aid Student Portal by use of your email and text messages to keep abreast of any documents needed prior to the disbursement of your loans.

Federal Direct Loans Continued

CAMPUS IVY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Once logged into the Campus Ivy Virtual Financial Aid Student portal, students will notice that there are required documents which must be completed in order to receive Federal Direct Loans.

Please note: You are only required to complete these documents once every academic year!

- **Identification Student**. The *Identification Student* is how Campus Ivy proves your identity. You may take a picture of your government issued identification and upload the picture to Campus Ivy. Note: your picture must show all four edges of your government issued identification to be valid.
- **Funding Estimate.** The *Funding Estimate* or Award Letter is the statement of your acceptance of funding for the academic year. The Director of Financial Aid begins this form process on your behalf. You must then sign this document to receive your award disbursement.

External Grants & Scholarships

- 1. Students are encouraged to seek external grants through various organizations and your home denomination.
- 2. Students are encouraged to search and apply for grants and scholarships using the internet.
- The Financial Aid Office has grant opportunities that are posted in the Brightspace HUB in the Financial Aid module.
- For more detailed information, students are encouraged to make an appointment with the Financial Aid Office to discuss their options.

Matching Scholarship Program (Doctoral Students Only)

- If a student is sponsored by a church/ministry context, Eden will match the church/ministry context funding given for a student on a dollar for dollar basis up to 1/3 of tuition charged each semester.
- Doctoral Students may only take advantage of one scholarship program per academic year.
