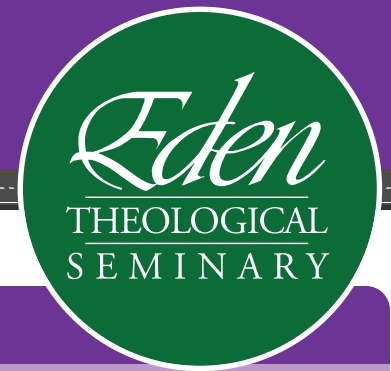


Road Map for the DMin Degree Program
