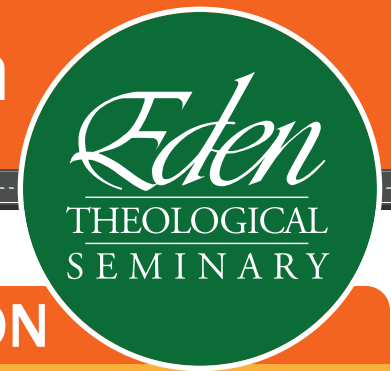


Road Map for the MAPS Degree Program

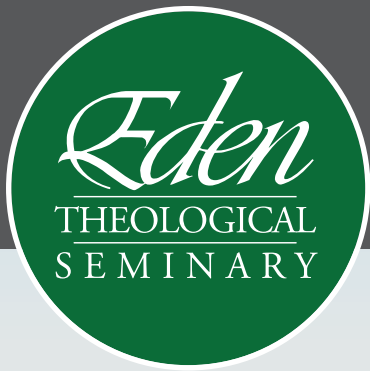
