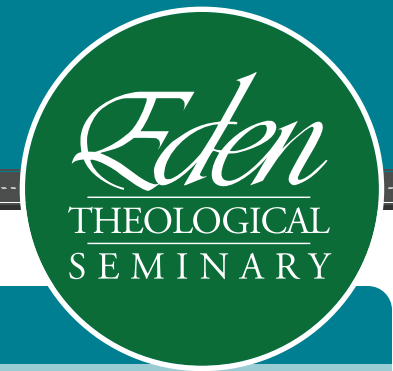


Road Map for the MCL Degree Program

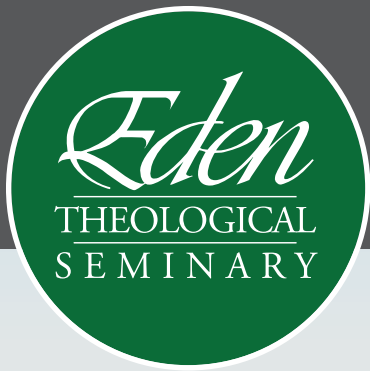
