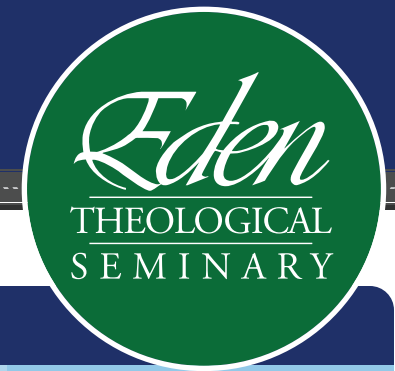


Road Map for the MTS Degree Program

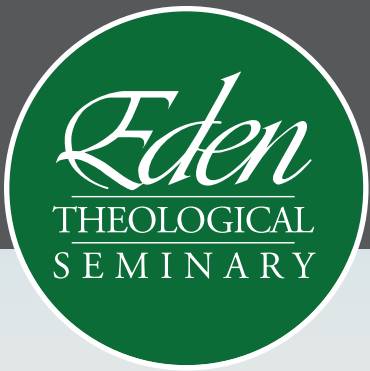
